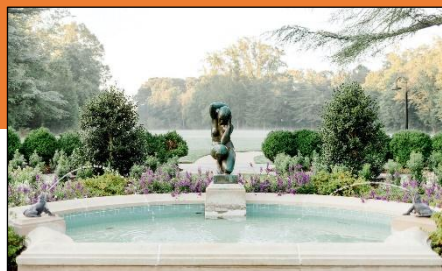

WYETH AT REYNOLDA



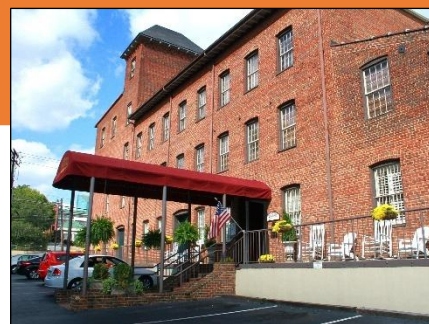
Visit the 1917 estate of R.J. & Katharine Reynolds & take in the exhibit, **Andrew Wyeth at Kuerner Farm: The Eye of the Earth**, a thorough examination of the artist's seven decades of painting a particular farm in his hometown. At a one-night-only event, hear from the exhibition curators in conversation with the artist's granddaughter, **Victoria Wyeth**, as she shares personal stories of growing up with this American painter. Afterwards, at the **Barn at Reynolda Village**, enjoy live music & savory bites during a farm-to-table dinner reception featuring chef **Jordan Rainbolt of Native Root Cuisine**.

MUSEUM OF SOUTHERN DECORATIVE ARTS (MESDA)



After breakfast, enjoy a guided behind-the-scenes tour of **MESDA**, a museum dedicated to the preservation & scholarship of southern decorative arts & culture. In the early 1900s, southern antiques were mostly dismissed by scholars & ignored by collectors. A movement to challenge the existing attitudes began in 1949 that ultimately led to MESDA's opening in 1965, the results of which have extended beyond their exhibitions to include groundbreaking field research, award-winning publications, a respected research center & library, & exceptional educational programs.

BROOKSTOWN INN



Enjoy one night at the historic **Brookstown Inn**, located less than a mile from Old Salem. The hotel's site was first the home of Salem Manufacturing Co., a mill constructed in 1837. It continued as a milling company until 1942 when it became warehouse space. In 1978, the Brookstown Rehabilitation Project converted the building to a 41-room hotel. A restaurant was added in 1984 & 30 more rooms were added in 1991. New renovations in 2013 created the Brookstown Inn you will come to know & love.
